- Solid Waste Agency Presentation: Packets are at City Hall.
- Chipper Quotes: Council has chosen to hold on chipper purchase to track to see if public works would have used chipper to determine if worth investing in.
- Planning and Zoning: Drahos: Planning and zoning did not have a quorum at the meeting to vote and has been rescheduled for May 20<sup>th</sup>.
- Tree Bids: Fehr Graham did study for right of way about 5 ft culvert on 2<sup>nd</sup> street, clearing right of way gives opportunity to regrade ditch, that has caused drainage issues to downtown.
  - Franks underbrush: \$4,000, \$4,000 for trees.
  - D&D: Underbrush: \$6,350, \$4,275 for trees.

  - D&D Tree Service: \$2,450.00
  - Klimek makes a motion to use Ahnastone Productions LLC for \$1,950 if includes stump grinding. MSB: Mulholland. Aye: Hall, Klimek, Mulholland, Price. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

## • Correspondence:

- Council Member Hall: To extend the playground at the park and move the chair, the mulch that is approved by insurance and meets state guideline it is \$880 for a truck load and \$300 for the black boarder.
- Council Member Price: Mechanicville telephone and fiber is running through Bertram and goal is to have everyone hooked up by end of summer. Let city know of any right of way issues.
- Council Member Price: City Clerk Morahan has been working on letters to remove sidewalks.
  Due to Fehr Graham study if any sidewalks in town the whole town has to have sidewalks, without a grant the city will not put sidewalks into the whole town. Will check with Pelling to see if they will take the concrete chucks. Sidewalks in from of City Hall and township hall will remain.
